WHEREAS, the Bergen County Open Space, Recreation, Floodplain Protection, Farmland & Historic Preservation Trust Fund (“County Trust Fund”), provides matching grants to municipal governments and to nonprofit organizations for assistance in the development or redevelopment of outdoor municipal recreation facilities; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Arlington desires to further the public interest by obtaining a matching grant of \$210,000.00 from the County Trust Fund to fund the following project: the revitalization of Columbus Park through the development of accessible walking paths, a decorative plaza & a central gathering space, and installation of a shade structure(s).

WHEREAS, the governing body/board has reviewed the County Trust Fund Program Statement, and the Trust Fund Municipal Program Park Improvement application and instructions, and desires to make an application for such a matching grant and provide application information and furnish such documents as may be required; and,

WHEREAS, as part of the application process, the governing body/board received held the required Public Hearing to receive public comments on the proposed park improvements in the application on May 14, 2026; and,

WHEREAS, the County of Bergen shall determine whether the application is complete and in conformance with the scope and intent of the County Trust Fund; and,

WHEREAS, the applicant is willing to use the County Trust Fund in accordance with such rules, regulations and applicable statutes, and is willing to enter into an agreement with the County of Bergen for the above named project and ensure its completion on or about the project contract expiration date.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of North Arlington:

1. That it is hereby authorized to submit the above completed project application to the County by the deadline of **APRIL 24th 2026**, as established by the County; and,

RESO RE: AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR THE MANAGEMENT ENHANCEMENT REVIEW PROGRAM (MERP) GRANT

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey has appropriated \$1.5 million for Management Enhancement Review Program Grants to assist local units in studying operational efficiencies and reduced costs; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Community Affairs, Division of Local Government Services (DLGS) is tasked with administering these grant funds through the Management Enhancement Review Program (MERP); and

WHEREAS, MERP Grants exist to support costs associated with studying new technologies, organizational structures, and shared services opportunities to ensure that meaningful, efficiency generating initiatives are not hindered by short term expenses; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this study is to conduct the North Arlington IT & Cybersecurity Efficiency Study, including a comprehensive assessment of the Borough’s information technology systems, cybersecurity posture, administrative operations, and digital service capabilities, with the goal of improving efficiency, ensuring CJIS compliance, reducing long-term costs, and identifying opportunities for modernization and shared services, which will benefit the residents of the Borough of North Arlington; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Arlington will provide a local match in an amount not to exceed \$12,500, representing its share of the total project cost; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of North Arlington that the Borough will apply for a Management Enhancement Review Program Grant in the amount of \$50,000 to support the study of local operations, and if awarded and upon execution of said Agreement, the Borough does accept the Terms and Conditions specified in the Agreement in connection to this grant award.

CALENDAR YEAR 2026 ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK (N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14)

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget up to 2% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of North Arlington in the County of Bergen finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2026 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough Council hereby determines that a 1.5 % increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$334,675 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough Council hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.
